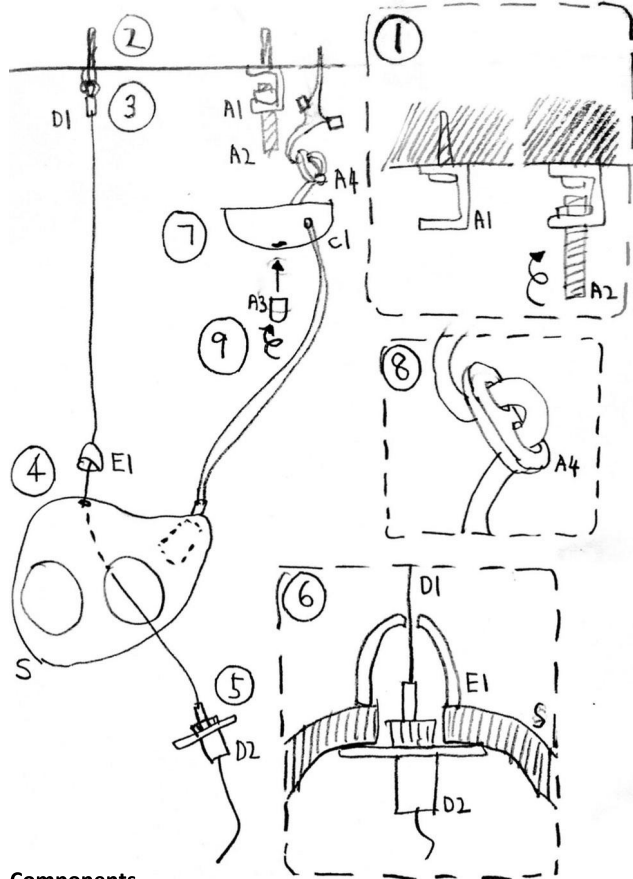


Diagram to install single lamp

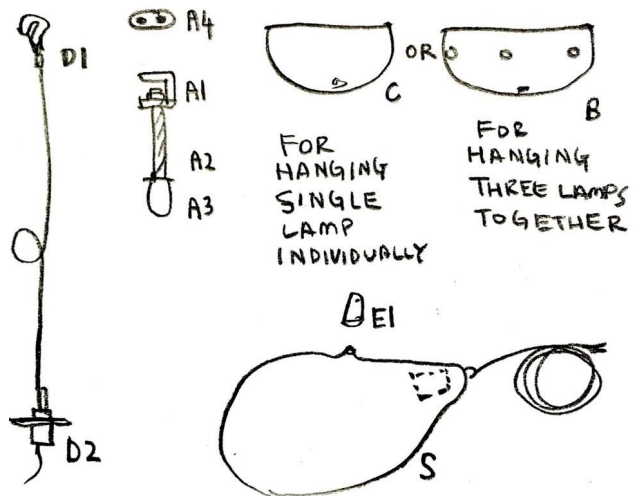
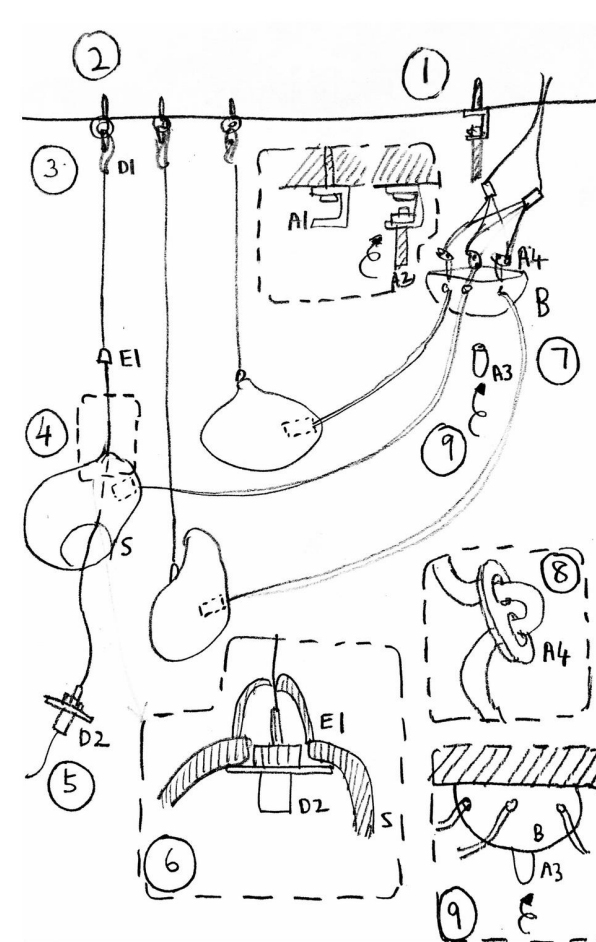


Diagram to install multiple lamps



## You See a Sheep Pendant Lamp Installation Guide

Disconnect the power before installing. All electrical work must be done by a qualified electrician.

1. Install a hickey (A1) to a ceiling junction box. Attach the threaded pipe with a nut (A2) to the hickey.
  2. Mark where the lamp will be hung and install an eye-hook (not included) securely with appropriate hardware for the ceiling type.
  3. Attach the cable assembly by clipping on the cable gripper (D1) to the eye-hook. Pull the cable to make sure the gripper is securely holding the cable. The cable can be released by pressing the small button on the cable gripper.
  4. Run the cable end through the ceramic cap (E1) and then the hole of the ceramic body (S).
  5. Attach the body gripper assembly (D2) to the cable at a desired drop length. Hold securely or place the ceramic body (S) on a secure flat surface while working. Turn the top knob of the gripper counterclockwise to loosen the cable. Depress the knob to adjust the height. Once the height is determined, it is important to secure the gripper by turning the knob clockwise so that the knob cannot be depressed at all. The excess cable can be trimmed.
  6. Place the ceramic body (S) so that it sits over the body gripper assembly (D2). Cover the cable exit with the ceramic cap (E1).
  7. Run the lamp wire through the side hole of the canopy.
  8. Loop each lamp wire through a strain relief (A4) inside the canopy so the lamp wire will not be pulled through the holes. Connect the wires.
- To install multiple lamps together with one canopy connection, repeat the step 2 to 8.
9. Push the canopy against the ceiling to house the wire connections and then secure it by screwing the finial (A3).
